Economic Impact of Cycling Tourists

Locally

- Le Tour de Norfolk \$173K (2014)
- Great Waterfront Trail Adventure \$184K (2017)



Provincially (2014)

- 1.7M cycling visits
- \$428M of total visitor spending
- Cyclists spend more per trip than noncyclists \$255 vs \$171
