On behalf of Norfolk Pathways for People, this letter is in support of the Nature Conservancy of Canada's application for support from Mountain Equipment Co-op to create a trail that connects the newly acquired DeMaere 2 and Soenen 2 properties to existing trails on the Backus Woods property.

Backus Woods is an outstanding example of mature Carolinian forest with old growth characteristics that offers hiking and nature viewing opportunities year round.
